Definition

- **2-4 people learning together to be like Jesus**

Purpose

To build Christ-centered relationships through sharing and encouraging other members to be like Jesus the servant (Philippians 2:5-8)

Purpose Notes

Note 1: Bible study/reflection is essential to becoming like Jesus. However, serious Scripture study should occur in addition to the above micro-group hour.

Note 2: The focus of the micro-group should be building relationships through sharing how we are learning to serve like him rather than content. If the group focus is on content, time for honest sharing is less likely to happen.

Method

- **Weekly scheduled contact**

(in person, by phone, via Zoom, etc.)

Time

- **One hour maximum**

Leadership

- **After establishing pattern of meeting, leadership weekly rotates to the next person**

Agenda

- 1. Report most significant events in last week**

- 2. Report one thing did you do to be Jesus hands and feet**
- 3. Find a Scripture that backs up how you reflected Jesus**
- 4. Share 2 or 3 key things others can pray for in the next week**
- 5. Optional: Choose a verse/passage to discuss next week**

Commitment

- **Each member commits to begin another micro-group that they will lead within one or two months**

Life Span

- **Three months**
- **or, as long as the members want to continue**
